### Is It Time to Clean Your Upholstery? Here's How to Tell:

- **Do the "Pillow Test"** Whack a cushion with a broom handle. See a dust cloud? Time to clean.
- Check Skin Contact Zones—Check areas where heads, necks or arms rest, or hands grab. Are the areas oily, discolored, or—yikes—crusty?
- The Sniff Test Smell your sofa. If it doesn't smell fresh, it needs attention.
- Got any biological boo-boos? Pet issues, potty training, vomit, drool, dog butt wipes?
- Visible stains or soil? Obvious dirt or old spills?

## Dangerous Myth About Upholstery Cleaning X "You shouldn't clean upholstery."

Wrong! Upholstery may *look* clean, but it harbors germs, bacteria, body oils, dust mites, allergens, pesticides—even chemicals from clothing. You wouldn't sleep on unwashed sheets for six months. Why sit on a sofa that's been absorbing life's messes for years?

### **General Upholstery Care Tips**

- **Vacuum regularly** Including in crevices and under cushions.
- Rotate cushions- to distribute wear evenly
- Avoid sun damage- UV rays weaken and fade fabric
- **Keep pets off-** their oils and dander can be difficult to remove
- Watch your wardrobe- Denim and dark clothing can rub off and transfer onto the fabric

## What to Do When Spills Happen

- 1. **Blot, don't rub** Use a clean, absorbent cloth immediately.
- 2. Check the fabric code- Use only cleaners recommended for your fabric type.
- 3. Use distilled water If water is required, especially for "W" or "WS" coded fabrics.
- 4. Always pre-test In an inconspicuous area to check for dye bleed or texture change.
- 5. **Blot outward** From the center of the stain to the edges.
- 6. **Dry quickly** Use a fan or cool blow dryer to avoid water marks or mildew.
- 7. Call us Some spills are best handled by professionals! Don't risk worsening the damage!
